MOOR MOVIES IN WINSFORD 2022

Tuesday 18th January: The Courier (12A)

The true story of British businessman Greville Wynne (Benedict Cumberbatch) unwittingly recruited into one of the greatest international conflicts in history. Forming an unlikely partnership in the hope of preventing a nuclear confrontation, Wynne and Soviet officer Oleg Penkovsky work together to provide the crucial intelligence used to defuse the Cuban Missile Crisis.

Tuesday 15th February: Nowhere Special (12A)

Inspired by a true story, *Nowhere Special* features James Norton as thirty-five-year-old window cleaner John, who has dedicated his life to bringing up his son Michael, after the child's mother left them soon after giving birth. When John is given only a few months to live, he attempts to find a new, perfect family for his four-year-old son, determined to shield him from the terrible reality of the situation.

Tuesday 15th March: King Richard (12A)

Based on the inspiring true story, *King Richard* follows the journey of Richard Williams, a determined father instrumental in raising two of the most extraordinarily gifted athletes of all time. Driven by a clear vision of their future and using unconventional methods, Richard (Will Smith) has a plan that will take Venus and Serena Williams from the streets of Compton, California to the global stage as legendary icons. The film shows the power of family, perseverance and unwavering belief as a means to achieve the impossible and impact the world.

Tuesday 5th April: Stillwater (15)

With more than a nod to the Meredith Kercher affair, *Stillwater* follows Bill Baker (Matt Damon), an American oil-rig roughneck from Oklahoma who travels to Marseille to visit his estranged daughter in prison for a murder she claims she did not commit. Confronted with language barriers, cultural differences, and a complicated legal system, Bill builds a new life for himself in France as he makes it his personal mission to exonerate his daughter.

Tuesday 26th April: Spencer (12A)

The marriage of Princess Diana (Kristen Stewart) and Prince Charles (Jack Farthing) has long since grown cold. Though rumours of affairs and a divorce abound, peace is ordained for the Christmas festivities at the Queen's Sandringham Estate. There's eating and drinking, shooting and hunting. Diana knows the game. But this year, things will be profoundly different. *Spencer* is an imagining of what might have happened during those few fateful days.
